OCCUPANCY PERMIT

§4-101. Permit Required.

No person or persons, firm or corporation shall move into or occupy any structure within the Township of Brecknock without first securing from the Township Secretary a permit for such occupancy.

§4-102. Zoning Officer Approval.

Any person or persons, firm or corporation desiring to occupy any new or remodeled structure within the Township of Brecknock shall not so occupy the same unless or until the Township Zoning Officer has approved the new or remodeled structure for occupancy and an occupancy permit is procured from the Township Secretary.

§4-103. Permit Fee.

The Secretary of the Township shall, upon application being made as provided for in §4-101 of this Part, issue a permit for a change which shall be in an amount as established by resolution, from time to time, by the Township Supervisors, setting forth names of the owners and occupiers and the address of where the structure is to be occupied.

§4-104. Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part, or who furnish false information to the Township Secretary, upon conviction thereof in an action brought before a district justice in the manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 90 days. Each day that a violation of this part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.
