MEMBERSHIP DUES ARE DUE WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE APPLICATION IS PROCESSED. A PORTION OF YOUR DUES IS NOT DEDUCTIBLE FOR INCOME TAX PURPOSES. Certain provisions of the Tax Act regarding lobbying expenses limit the extent to which your national, state, and local dues can be deducted for income tax purposes. We have been advised by the National Association of REALTORS® that a percentage of each member's dues are declared not deductible for income tax purposes based upon the relationship of the association's total dues income to the association's total lobbying expenditures. The percentages are: 35% of NAR \$201 dues (\$70.35), 5% of PAR \$198 dues (\$9.90) and 7% of R-BAR \$295 dues (\$20.65). The \$45 NAR Consumer Advertising assessment is included in your national dues. This assessment fee is not pro-rated and qualifies as deductible dues. We have been further advised that even if a member pays 2026 dues in full by the end of 2025, the portion of their 2026 dues used for lobbying expenses cannot be deducted on their 2025 income tax return. All membership dues and application fees are generally nonrefundable.
